Date of Liturgy and theme	Date:	Evangelisation 'Go out to the whole world; proclaim the Good News.'
Focus	Examples: Candle, Prayer Focus, open Bible? A vine image or grapes Candle, Prayer Focus, open Bible? Crucifix, Symbols of being a disciples.	
Gathering	<i>How are we prayerfully going to begin our prayer time? Light a candle, play some music, invite students to bless themselves with holy water</i>	
Introduction	<i>Our Gospel this week reveals to us Jesus praying for His friends and asks His Father to watch over them. This is in anticipation of Jesus knowing He would suffer, die, rise and ascend into glory. Jesus is asking the father to give His Apostles the strength to stay true to His word.</i>	
The Word (Scripture or reflection)	<p style="text-align: center;">Gospel</p> <p style="text-align: center;">A reading from the Gospel of John</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Gospel John 17:11-19</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Jesus raised his eyes to heaven and said: 'Holy Father, keep those you have given me true to your name, so that they may be one like us. I have watched over them and not one is lost But now I am coming to you and while still in the world I say these things to share my joy with them to the full. I passed your word on to them, I am not asking you to remove them from the world, but to protect them from the evil one. Consecrate them in the truth; your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world, and for their sake I consecrate myself so that they too may be consecrated in truth.'</p>
